Roles and Expectations

Duties of a Youth Board Member

- Attend Board meetings and provide input where possible
- Supporting ACF events through promotion, preparation, attendance and helping on the night
- Provide feedback on funding applications
- Maintain confidentiality throughout all ACF activities
- Offer support to other Board members if you see an opportunity to help
- Engage in email threads and respond
- Provide feedback to the Board about your time in the position
